### New Business

1. Discuss/Vote for ramp improvements for Cascade Annex – Haily

SAC's money to support projects and improvements across campus can be used to improve the ramp in the dock for Cascade Annex which provide access to Science Stores. Current ramp is 18 in wide which is barely the width of a hand truck. New ramp could improve maneuverability, ramp angle, and weight limits for freight. ½ funds from SAC, ½ funds from OccHealth budget, installation and ordering done by CPFM. Committee member asks if this would solve the ADA access issue in this particular area. There are other ADA access points to the buildings, but the slope would still need to be compliant with ADA regulations. Committee member asks if it was designed to be used outside/in rain. Request passed by vote.

Committee member asks about a separate issue that had come up with KC2 about a near invisible pane of glass and if that would be solved through the SAC funding. This issue will be covered by the project itself since the building has been open for two weeks and a Certificate of Occupancy hasn't been issued yet.

2. Presentation on Sidewalk Mapping – Haily  
Every three years OccHealth maps the sidewalks to assess damage and mark areas that are uneven to prioritize addressing issues. More will be presented next month by the project lead, Justin Zunker.
3. Kids on Campus – Ruby  
Happening on April 30<sup>th</sup>, SRS will be at McArthur Court.
4. SRS website SharePoint transition – Hayden  
Website has been improved over the last two years, there will be future improvements and moving some assets to Sharepoint behind Shibboleth.
5. Wildfire Smoke Training Updates – Haily  
Training and resources are updated to move from AQI system. Use of WeatherStem a weather monitoring system which has been added to the roof of PLC. This system is where all Eugene Campus people will be directed to during any weather event but especially for monitoring smoke concentrations for outdoor work.
