	Debra McLaughlin: COVID testing trends	Significant uptick in student COVID testing before spring break travel
	Haily Griffith: Resumption Plans per department	EHS can do physical audit of your area and resumption plan upon request
	Shawn Kahl: cont. resumption plans per department	Do individual departments understand the details of their resumption plans? How can we assure they do?
	Jeani Williams: Department of Education COVID response	EC Cares has to follow guidance from several entities – school district, university, state guidelines, etc.

	Lisa – Decreased traffic during COVID, but we are seeing traffic incidents on campus become more common. Why?	It is likely that people have forgotten what it's like to drive on campus. Corresponding national phenomenon of less drivers on the road, yet increased accidents
