	Haily: Moving back to campus & Slip/trip/fall risks	Haily: Share "Safely Moving Back to Campus" Safety Sheet – concerns carrying objects and obstructed view risk
	Kyle: "Masks Required" signage not taken down in buildings yet. Whose responsibility is this?	CPFM & Building managers working to remove signage from campus buildings
	Ruby: concerns about removal of carpet signage	Kevin: Custodial is currently working on resetting classrooms – they are removing carpet signage during classroom re-sets
	Gary: CDC guidelines still recommends 3 ft. separation - 18-23" separation was pre-COVID norm.	Haily: Noticed continued distance despite removed guidelines. OSHA has removed standard, so legality is mute
	Gary: Smoke procedures for Summer 2021 – reassigning work duties	CPFM: N95 fit testing for essential jobs in response to wildfire smoke. Haily: KN95s also available for voluntary program
	Steve: Rulemaking process w/ OR-OSHA for wildfire smoke response	Wildfire smoke response is informed by this program – UO policy made accordingly
	Shawn: HVAC systems & wildfire smoke – is 100% outside drawn, no re-circulation allowed?	Kevin: Yes, this can be done. HVAC systems already temporarily changed during heatwave 2021
