Question was regarding if it was overloaded or incorrectly installed. Investigation was inconclusive. Collapse did not cause injury, but would have if it had struck someone. Ferenc reminded everyone to not install cabinets by yourself. Call CPFM. Wall penetrations could have asbestos. Trades Maintenance employees will follow asbestos procedures and will also ensure that the cabinets are securely and correctly installed.
