	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Haily: Working remote – fundamental changes seen as work environments changed</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• What challenges will we face bringing campus community back to in-person?</li> </ul>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Shawn – employees coming back into spaces &amp; not wanting to wear masks</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Employee “comfort” does not override CDC, UO and State guidelines/policies</li> </ul>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Lisa – Decreased traffic during COVID, but we are seeing traffic incidents on campus become more common. Why?</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• It is likely that people have forgotten what it’s like to drive on campus. Corresponding national phenomenon of less drivers on the road, yet increased accidents</li> </ul>
