

# HAZARDOUS MATERIAL RELEASE

#### **BEFORE**

- 1. Be familiar with your hazardous materials and associated Safety Data Sheets (SDS).
- 2. Understand your work area's safety procedures and location of safety equipment and spill kit.

#### **DURING**

- 1. Notifications:
  - Call 911 if the situation is life-threatening.
  - If not life-threatening call UOPD at 541-346-2919 and request Environmental Health and Safety assistance.
- 2. Containment and Control:
  - Notify others in the area of the release.
  - Contain the spill and protect interior and exterior drains, if safe to do so.
  - Avoid inhalation of air contaminants.
  - Leave the contaminated area and prevent access to the release area.
  - Obtain SDS and provide to incident responders.

#### 3. First aid:

- Rinse exposed skin or eyes for at least
  15minutes. Use safety fixtures if
- Remove contaminated clothing and place in aliquid-tight, closed container.
- Assist others if safe to do so. Use protective equipment.

## If you are instructed to shelter-in-place:

- 1. Close windows and doors, seal gaps around them.
- 2. When possible, turn off room air ventilation systems. **Do not** turn off hazmat control systems.

### **AFTER**

1. Review incident. Identify root cause and implement prevention measures.



Ensure materials are secured properly.



Prevent spills of potentially hazardous materials from entering sewer drains.



Notify first responders. Emergency 911. EHS 541-346-3192. UOPD 541-346-2919.
