



The Office of Risk Management protects the university's assets through identifying and analyzing exposures, controlling those exposures, mitigating risks, financing losses, and implementing and monitoring the risk management process.

### INSURANCE PROGRAM

The university has an independent insurance structure. UO procures 23 lines of insurance and has self-insured retentions that flow directly into the private insurer level. The university has various types of insurance or self-insurance to cover the different risks the institution faces. These include general liability, property, fine arts, international travel, day care, camps and clinics, athletics, and workers compensation.
