	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Haily Discusses KN95’s supply 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • N95's available on a voluntary basis for smoke related concerns, however in the interest of conserving for frontline workers EHS is recommending KN95's instead
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Theodora asked the difference between the N95 and KN95 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The main difference between the two masks is the KN95 does not provide as tight of a seal. This is more comfortable for the wearer but makes them slightly less effective than the N95.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Haily noted an ash removal process is being developed for exterior and interior cleanup 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Clean up – use wet methods, with low pressure & go slowly. This lessens amount of ash kicked back up in air.
